What:

- STSMs are exchange visits
- support individual mobility, strengthen existing networks, foster collaboration between COST Action Participants
- allow to learn new techniques, gain access to specific data, instruments and methods not available in their own institutions/ organisations
- should specifically contribute to the scientific objectives of the COST Action



Who:

- STSM applicant can be any person with an e-COST profile
- STSM applicant must be engaged in an official research programme as a PhD Student or postdoctoral fellow

or

 employed by, or affiliated to, an institution, organisation or legal entity that clearly performs research.

How:

- Online applications on e-COST
- Selection of STSM grantees made by the STSM Coordinator / Committee
- STSMs must respect the following criteria:
 - They must have a minimum duration of 5 calendar days that includes travel
 - STSMs need to be carried out in their entirety within a single Grant Period and always within the Action's lifetime.



1st Grant Period (02/10/19 – 30/04/20)

- Call for applications Deadline Nov 30, 2019
- Total budget EUR 5200 Min 4 STSM grants
- Maximum budget granted to each approved STSM is EUR 1300 (EUR 3500 COST limit)
 - Max of 30 calendar days including travel
 - Max EUR 160 / day for accommodation and meal expenses
 - Max EUR 300 for travel costs





Evaluation criteria

- Priority to STSM applications of PhD students or ECI
- Priority to applicants from ITCs
- Gender balance
- Complementarity of resources home / hosting institution
- Clarity of activity planning
- Contribution to scientific obj. of Action / WG(s)
- Scientific and/or other motivation for the STSM
- Curriculum Vitae (CV)

- Activity plan must be consistent with duration of STSM
- Describe Impact on Action Contribution to WGs

 - Eurostat Purchasing Power Parities (PPPs)
 - indicators of price level differences across countries
