The main goal of the STSM was the study of speciation of GdCl₃ and Gd(III) - caffeic acid complexes in biological systems. For that purpose, inductively coupled plasma mass spectrometry (ICP-MS) was used in order to determine the concentration of the metal compounds and to study their speciation.
